The Centre works as a real working garage rather than a college environment to give learners the vital 'immersion' into a real working environment and teach them how to cope in a garage setting, with customers waiting. Profits buy tools for the learners.

IMI Award/Certificate in the Introduction to the Motor Vehicle Industry (Entry Level 3)

QAN: 601/8195/3 (Award) & 601/8196/5 (Certificate)

This Vocationally Related Qualification (VRQ) is designed to engage and motivate 14 - 19 year olds who are interested in learning about the automotive industry. It is ideal for those learners who wish to undertake a qualification that provides a stepping-stone to a career within the motor industry.

It involves a practical approach to learning and assessment and includes many visual questioning techniques, which stimulates and draws interest to the learners.

The qualifications combination of units provides learners with the flexibility in the choice of the areas they wish to develop their knowledge and skills in.

All learners will cover mandatory introductory units in Health & Safety, Communications, Career Pathways and Hand Tools relevant within the automotive industry.

Learners gain skills and an accredited qualification, something for their CV, confidence, real work experience and a reference should they show the right attitude.

This Award comprises Five units:

- Introduction to Health and Safety – ELMV01
- Introduction to Careers in Transportation, Maintenance and Repair – ELMV02
- Introduction to Hand Tools – ELMV03
- Communication in the Motor Vehicle Environment – ELMV04
- Introduction to Workshop Cleaning and Maintenance – ELMV07

For students completing the Entry-level Award, additional units can be studied in order to complete the Entry Level Certificate. This in turn can lead to the Level 1 IMI Award.

A Functional Skills Tutor is also available to support Entry Level, Level 1 and Level 2 Maths and English qualifications.
