Learners attending the Enhancement and Developing Futures provision in Balby will have the opportunity to complete the following Programme of Study specialising in the areas of Construction, Mechanics and Animal Care:

Award in Skills for Employment, Training and Personal Development (Entry 3) & Award in Using Employability Skills (Entry 3)

The NOCN Entry Level Award in Skills for Employment, Training and Personal Development (Entry 3) is designed to provide an introduction to working in the following sectors: Personal Development, Literacy and Numeracy, Animal Care and Motor Vehicle as well as more generic employability skills designed to build confidence for the workplace.

For Animal Care students, the units studied are:

- Introduction
- Work Experience
- Feeding Small Animals
- Working with Animals
- Assist with Catching and Restraining a Small Animal
- Groom a Small Animal
- Check that a Small Animal is Healthy

For Mechanics students, the units studied are:

- Work Experience
- Motor Vehicle Workshop Tools and Equipment
- Identification of Basic Internal and External Car Parts
- Checking and Maintaining Car Tyres
- Checking and Maintaining Fluid Levels on a Car
- Routine Vehicle Check
- Washing a Car Exterior

These qualifications will allow learners to progress onto a higher-level qualification.

Level 1 Award in Skills for Employment, Training and Personal Development

For Animal Care students, the units studied are:

- Introduction
- Work Experience
- Principles of Animal Care
- Principles of dealing with Feedstuffs for Small Animals
- Assist with Animal Accommodation
- Prepare for Interview
- Further Educational Enrichment Activity

For Mechanics students, the units studied are:

- Tools, Equipment and Materials for Vehicle Maintenance
- Identification of Basic Internal & External Car Parts
- Introduction to Vehicle Wheels and Tyres
- Checking and Maintaining a Cars Tyre Pressure and Tread
- Repair a Cycle Puncture
- Carry out a Systematic Cycle Check

Award in Introduction to Construction (Entry 3)

The NOCN Entry Level Award in Introduction to Construction (Entry 3) is designed to provide an introduction to the construction industry. Learners will gain knowledge on how to prepare for a career in construction.

This qualification is suitable for learners aged 14 years or over. The qualification will provide learners with an opportunity to:

- Gain an understanding about the different career opportunities in the construction industry.
- Gain an awareness of the importance of health and safety in construction.
- Gain an awareness about environmental issues relating to construction.

Learners will gain the knowledge and skills required to prepare for further training in construction.
